Cleaning & Preventative Maintenance

Atmospheric deposits, sulphurous acids, carbon dioxide, and other airborne chemicals can discolour, tarnish, and corrode decorative finishes over time.

Regular maintenance helps prevent these deposits from accumulating and damaging the metal.

While our lock ranges are constructed from durable materials that require minimal attention, they should not be neglected.

Implementing a simple cleaning routine will help maximise performance and extend the life cycle of the components, preserving their aesthetic value.

Cleaning Instructions:

- Wash exposed stainless steel areas monthly using a mild detergent and warm water, applied with a soft sponge.
- Rinse with clean water, then dry thoroughly with a soft duster or chamois leather.
- This process is sufficient to keep the system free from dirt and grime.

Important:

Do not use abrasive cleaners or materials on any part of the dormakaba products.

When using any detergents, it is recommended to wear rubber gloves and eye protection to prevent skin and eye contact with harmful chemicals.

Maintenance Guidelines:

Requirement	Suggested Method
Routine cleaning	Soap or mild detergent in warm water, rinse and wipe dry.
Fingerprints	Detergent and warm water, or alternatively, hydrocarbon solvent.
Oil & grease marks	Hydrocarbon solvent.

Additionally, ensure that all moving parts and strike plates are kept free of dirt and debris at all times. This will help prevent potential jamming or improper door closure.
